

# SPONSOR AN AFGHAN ORPHAN



International aid groups estimate that 28,000 children live on the streets of Kabul alone. A recent Nations Children's Fund survey found that two out of every three children interviewed had seen someone killed during the fighting in Kabul. Seven in 10 had lost a close relative to the war.

The extraction of human organs, mainly kidneys, from refugee children is rampant in Afghan refugee camps in Pakistan. Afghan children of eight or nine years of age are subjected to sexual violence, are beaten, and forced into child labor. Many turn to begging or crime to survive. A lack of medical facilities and adequate nutrition means that children are frequently the first to succumb to the ravages of infectious diseases.

It is not unheard-of for desperate parents to sell their own children because they are not able to feed and clothe them. Some have even killed their children rather than subject them to lives of abject misery.
